**STATUTORY MEASURE  
PROPOSITION A  
Referendum ordered by Petition**

Do the people of the state of Missouri want to adopt Senate Bill 19 ("Right-to-Work") as passed by the general assembly in 2017, which prohibits as a condition of employment the forced membership in a labor organization (union) or forced payments of dues in full or pro-rata (fair-share); make any activity which violates employees' rights illegal and ineffective; allow legal remedies for anyone injured as a result of another person violating or threatening to violate employees' rights; and which shall not apply to union agreements entered into before the effective date of Senate Bill 19?

State and local government entities expect no costs or savings.

SPECIAL SCHOOL LEVY ELECTION  
ELSBERRY R-II SCHOOL DISTRICT, MISSOURI**

**PROPOSITION 2**

Shall the Board of Education of the Elsberry R-II School District, Missouri, be authorized to increase the operating tax levy ceiling by \$0.25 to \$3.00 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation in order to provide additional funds to maintain its facilities and meet operating expenses of the District?

The district intends to reduce the debt service levy by \$0.2500 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation in order to offset the estimated \$0.2500 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation increase to the operating levy and will result in no net increase to the total tax levy if this Proposition is approved by the voters. Approval of this proposition increases the District's operating tax levy ceiling to \$3.00 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation and will be applied to the assessed valuation in tax year 2018 and each year thereafter.

**PROPOSITION F**

Shall the Hawk Point Fire Protection District issue its general obligation bonds in the amount of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, renovating, improving, maintaining and equipping fire stations and related facilities and acquiring new and replacement fire-fighting equipment and vehicles to carry out the objectives and purposes of the District?

The authorization of the bonds will authorize the levy and collection of an annual tax in addition to the other taxes provided for by law on all taxable tangible property in the District sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds as they fall due and to retire the same within twenty years from the date thereof.

**PROPOSITION U**

Shall the City of Old Monroe impose a local use tax at the same rate as the local sales tax rate, currently one-half percent (0.5%), provided that if the local sales tax rate is reduced or raised by voter approval, the local use tax rate shall also be reduced or raised by the same action? A use tax return shall not be required to be filed by persons whose purchases from out-of-state vendors do not in total exceed two thousand dollars in any calendar year.


