Office hours are Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The clerk's office will be closed on December 24th and 25th as well as January 1st in observance of holidays. Office hours on January 15th will be 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Ballot Placement will be determined pursuant to Section 115.395.2, RSMo. which states that; Candidates who file on the first day will select a number by random drawing. The random number drawn will determine the candidate's ballot placement. After the first day, candidates will be placed on the ballot in order of their filing.
