

REGISTERING TO VOTE IN LINCOLN COUNTY

In order to register to vote in Lincoln County, a person must:

- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Must be 17 ½ years of age (18 years old by Election Day)
- Must be a resident of Lincoln County

Registering to vote in Lincoln County is very easy. To register in person, come to the Lincoln County Courthouse at 201 Main Street in Troy. The Voter Registration Office is located in Room 104. You may also register to vote at the Troy License Bureau located at 850 E Cherry Street in Troy or at the Lincoln County Health Department located off of Highway H at 5 Health Department Drive in Troy.

You may also fill out the Lincoln CO Voter Registration Form on this website. Complete the form, print, sign, and mail the form to:

Any person moving into Lincoln County from another county or state is considered a new registration and must re-register by the deadline in order to be eligible to vote in an election. The deadline to register to vote is 5:00 PM on the fourth Wednesday prior to an election.

Keeping your registration up to date ensures that you have no delays at the polls on Election Day. Notify the Voter Registration Office in person or in writing to the above address if:

- You have a legal name change
- Have moved to a new address within the county
- Have moved out of Lincoln County (you must register with the Election Authority in the new county)
