

THE JANUARY TERM HELD ON THE 17TH DAY OF MARCH 2014

The County Commission convened at 9:05 a.m., pursuant to adjournment on March 11, 2014. Present: EuGene Galloway- Associate Commissioner District 1, Matt Bass-Associate Commissioner District 2, Crystal Hall, County Clerk. Dan Colbert-Presiding Commissioner, was absent as he was conducting interviews at Boonslick Regional Planning for the Executive Director position, the following proceedings were held:

Invocation given by Commissioner Bass.

Highway Department: Bruce Wallace & Don Lilley

- General maintenance issues were discussed.
- Karen Marvel, Clerk for Fountain N Lake has inquired about contracting the County for grading the streets in the village. Wallace will contact Mrs. Marvel with the hourly rate.
- Work has been completed on Keeteman Road to prevent erosion along the roadway.
- Bleigh Construction is scheduled to resume working on the Davis Bridge on March 24, 2014. Wallace will resume keeping a daily log for the project.
- Crews are power washing bridges and patching bridge decks as they continue to work from the list provided by Great River Associates to make needed improvements and repairs.
- The Commission asked that a sharp corner sign be put up on Frenchmen Bluff Road and that a hidden drive sign be placed on Argentville Road.
- The Commission asked that crews extend a box culvert on Gravens Road.
- Discussed potential dirt work on Old CapAuGris Road.

Maintenance Staff: Sam Clary

- General maintenance issues and work orders were discussed.
- Clary has repaired curbs which were damaged by snow plows.
- Clary has placed no parking signs at the warrant window at the 911 Center.
- Clary submitted state contract prices to replace the mower at the Court House. The current mower is more than 14 years old and needs approximately \$600.00 in repairs. The Commission authorized Clary to put together a purchase order to replace the mower.

Unfinished/New Business

- Chris Russell, Schaeffer's Oil Company introduced himself to the Commission and expressed his interest in doing business with the County.
- Michael Purol, Poepping, Stone, Bach & Associates, Inc., introduced himself to the Commission and offered an overview of the engineering and architectural services his company provides.
