- Burkemper presented the October Sales and Gas Tax Reports. Burkemper reports that sales tax was up 17.68% for the month compared to the same period during 2013 and remains up 9.99% for the year. Gas tax was up 1.4% for the month compared to the same period during 2013 and remains up 0.6% for the year.
- Discussed 911 dispatch fee collections.

Unfinished/New Business

- Discussed X-ray machine at the Justice Center. Randy Siebert reports that it might need a service call. Siebert will reset the machine in hopes that will resolve the problem.
- Commissioner Galloway made a motion to allow 1, 2, or 5 year flood plain lease agreements. Commissioner Bass second. The ayes carried the motion.
- Commissioner Bass made a motion to increase cell phone reimbursement to \$40.00 per month beginning January 1, 2015. Commissioner Galloway second. The ayes carried the motion.
- The minutes from October 20th, 21st, and 24th 2014 have been reviewed. Commissioner Bass made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Commissioner Galloway second. The ayes carried the motion.
