- O'Brien presented the June Sales and Gas Tax Reports. O'Brien reports that sales tax was up 3.9% for the month compared to the same period during 2015 and remains up 9.1% for the year. Gas tax was up 3.1% for the month compared to the same period during 2015 and is up 0.1% for the year.
- Commissioner Bass made a motion to transfer a Canon Copier with inventory tag# 1136 from the Treasurer's inventory to the County Clerk's inventory. Commissioner Colbert second. The ayes carried the motion.

Unfinished/New Business

- Commissioner Bass made a motion to rescind the obsolete 911 EMA Ordinance which was originally established to tie the 911 Center with the Emergency Management Department, Ordinance Number 10.15.2013-1. Commissioner Colbert second. The ayes carried the motion.
