- In the process of replacing toilet system in jail to ICOM system, at a cost of \$9,000 per pod.
- Looking into upgrading jail management system and records management system to a more cost effective option.
- Discussed 911 dispatch rates.

Unfinished/New Business

- Opened and read aloud On-Call Trucking Services: Lottery pick: 1) Mick Mehler & Sons 2) Eveland Excavating.
- Discussed 911 Dispatch user fee estimated rate increase for 2018.
