- O'Brien presented the Sales and Gas Tax Reports for the month of July. O'Brien reports that sales tax was up 20.7% for the month and remains up 5.5% for the year compared to the same period during 2016. Gas tax was up 4.0% for the month and remains up 2.4% for the year compared to the same period during 2016.
