The following proceedings were held:

- General road maintenance items were discussed.
- Discussed seasonal workers to help with mowing during the summer months.
- Commissioner Bass made a motion to hire Neal Matlock as a seasonal employee at the Highway Department for \$14.00 per hour. Commissioner Mueller second. All ayes to carry the motion.
- Commissioner Mueller made a motion to hire Tim Cato as a full time employee at the Highway Department, with a starting rate of \$14.00 per hour. Commissioner Bass second. All ayes to carry the motion.
- Commissioner Mueller made a motion to hire Kevin Paris as a full time employee at the Highway Department, with a starting rate of \$14.00 per hour. Commissioner Bass second. All ayes to carry the motion.
- Discussed upcoming road improvements on Giles Road.
- Discussed the potential paving schedule for summer of 2019.
- Discussed dump truck inventory and repairs needed.

- Brett Siefert and Amanda Ingram, Lincoln County Health Department, discussed proposed ordinance change to the Professional On-Site Sewage Disposal Ordinance 1995-12-Revised April 1999.
- Commissioner Bass made a motion to revise the Lincoln County On-Site Sewage Disposal Ordinance# 1995-12, authorizing the Health Department to increase the bond amount from \$10,000.00 to \$25,000.00 for professional on-site sewage disposal system installers (*3.11D). - Mike Wood, Prosecuting Attorney, discussed the transition of his office and new policies that have been implemented in an effort to be more efficient, building and maintenance concerns, and storage needed for evidence.
